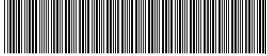

Your protest must be in writing and postmarked or hand delivered by **05/22/2023**. The enclosed protest form may be used to file your written protest. The ARB will begin hearings at 1301 E. 8th Street on **06/05/2023**.

You can easily access information regarding your property taxes, including information regarding the amount of taxes each entity that taxes your property will impose if the entity adopts its proposed tax rate. Your local property tax database will be updated regularly during August and September as local elected officials propose and adopt the property tax rates that will determine how much you pay in property taxes.

"The Texas Legislature does not set the amount of your local taxes. Your property tax burden is decided by your locally elected officials and all inquiries concerning your taxes should be directed to those officials."
